## ITEM 5 APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE JACTS FY 2023-2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

The following amendments to the JACTS FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) were presented to the committee:

- City of Jackson
  - Deletion of a Traffic Flow Improvement project on Lansing Ave for FY25, estimated at \$1,311,000.
  - Addition of a Cold Mill and Resurfacing project on Brown St for FY25, estimated at \$346,425.
  - Addition of a Road Widening project on Blackstone St for FY25, estimated at \$283,588.
- Jackson Area Transportation Authority
  - Phase budget adjustment on a SP1303-Bus Shelter Purchase project for FY24, estimated at \$131,034.
  - o Addition of a SP1809-Safety project for FY24, estimated at \$20,404.
- Jackson County Department of Transportation
  - Funding adjustment for a Road Rehabilitation project on Sutton Rd for FY25, estimated at \$1,008,738.
  - Addition of the Early Preliminary Engineering phase for a Road Safety Audit project at various locations for FY24, estimated at \$20,000.
  - Deletion of the Construction phase for a Road Safety Audit project at various locations for FY24, estimated at \$20,000.

A motion was made by Mr. Dowling, supported by Chair Kilne, to approve the amendments to the JACTS FY 2023-2026 TIP as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

  place at the start of the new fiscal year in October.
- Ms. Strach announced a stakeholder meeting for the MDOT University Region Active Transportation Plan on June 26. Information on plan development was also provided.
- Mr. Gatz announced that the Jackson County Recreation Plan survey is now public, which includes questions regarding the development of non-motorized trails.

#### **Construction:**

I-94 at Elm Road, Lansing Ave. and West Ave. (US-127) reconstruction, also includes resurfacing on US-127 (I-94 to Parnall) — Clean up, signing, turf establishment and other various items of work remain.

I-94 from M-60 to Calhoun County line – Reconstruction from M-60 to Michigan Ave, major rehabilitation from Michigan Ave to Calhoun County line – (2022-2025 construction). Traffic has been shifted on WB I-94 and one lane of EB I-94 is shifted to the westbound roadway. EB I-94 lane closures will be occurring Monday morning until Friday morning to rebuild the eastbound roadway. Ramp closures on EB I-94 will be occurring at the Sandstone Rest Area, Michigan Ave and M-60. The Parma EB ramps are open on Friday thru Sunday. The Dearing Road bridge over I-94 and all ramps at the Dearing Road interchange are closing June 7<sup>th</sup> until near Labor Day.

Cooper (M-50/US-127BR) over abandoned RR, north of High and south of Morrell – Preventative maintenance bridge repairs. Final repairs will be occurring the next couple weeks.

Traffic signal modernization on Cooper Street and MLK (Washington, Glick, Ganson, Leroy, Parnall, South, Morrell, & High. MLK at Ganson.) – Work is substantially complete.

US-127 Freeway Signing Upgrade (Parnall to Ingham County Line and Floyd to I-94) – Work began this winter and will last thru the summer. Periodic lane closures and shoulder closures will occur.

Martin Luther King Jr. Drive (Old M-106) from Louis Glick to Cooper – Preventative maintenance resurfacing and sidewalk ramps. Sidwalk ramp work is underway. Resurfacing is expected to occur the week of July 22<sup>nd</sup> and will require short term detours.

M-50 from East of Clinton Way to M-99 – Preventative maintenance chip seal with fog seal. Shoulder gravel and pavement markings remain.

Cooper Street (M-106) bridge replacement in downtown Jackson south of train station and Louis Glick (I-94BL) deck replacement near Mechanic Street – late 2024/2025 Construction.

#### Design:

**US-127 northbound ramp to Westbound I-94** – Safety project. High friction surface treatment. 2025 construction.

**US-127 at Jefferson Road** – Bridge repairs. 2025 construction.

M-106 over Portage River – Bridge repairs. 2025 construction.

**Cooper Street (M-106) from Michigan Ave to North Street** – Preventative maintenance resurfacing and sidewalk ramps. 2026 construction.

## JACTS Airport Update July 2024

- Control tower rehab is ongoing. Work on building electrical system, ventilation system and new fire alarm system has started. Work on the control cab is to start in early August.
- Veregy has completed replacement of the airport terminal building air conditioning units.
- Terminal building rehabilitation project will have the 90% design meeting with FAA and MDOT on July 11. If approved by MDOT, FAA and Jackson County, we expect to go out for bids in September or October 2024 with construction for 2025.
- We are still waiting for the start of the airport water main and storm water improvements project.
